



- 5. Open the lid and pull the console safe up and unfold the leg so that it is against the wall of the console.
- 6. Figure 2: Slide the #7.5 Left Leg over the inner flange of the collar and bolt with (2) #7.3" #10-32x1/2 flat head screw and (2) #7.1 1/4" Nylock Nut.



7. Figure 3: With the left leg fully extended and right leg attached, install the #7.6 Left and #7.7 Right Mounting Brackets using (4) #7.2 screws.



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9. **Figure 5:** Assemble the lid support hardware (*Found in the Key Bag*). Tighten the hardware in small increments so that the lid remains supported (*usually self-supporting at a 45-degree lid angle*).

NOTE: One of the #7.8.3 Nylon Washers (shown to the left of the slotted arm) slips between the slotted arm and the stationary frame.

NOTE: Over time, the friction that holds the lid in the open position may be reduced. To increase the friction, it is necessary to tighten the assembly. Tighten in small increments as required, **removal of the Console Safe should not be necessary.**
