Rock Slider - Driver (1) Rock Slider - Passenger (1)

Hardware Bag Kit BU21839 Contents:

1/4-20 x 1 Bolt, Grade 8 Y/Z (10) 1/4-20 Stover Nut (10) 1/4 SAE Flat Washer, Grade 8 Y/Z (20) Plastic Clips (6) 3/16" High Tensil Steel Rivets (60)

The installation of this product requires a 3/16" capable air powered rivet gun and a small 3/8" drill with 3/16" and 1/4" drill bits. It also requires minor trimming using a cutoff wheel or sheetmetal sheers. It is recommended the installation is performed by a professional.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE STARTING.

Important! All upper holes in the door jamb are 3/16" (rivet holes) and the lower holes through the pinchweld are 1/4" (bolt holes).

Identify driver and passenger rockers and orientation. They are labeled.

Install 1 side at a time.

REMOVING PLASTIC ROCKER COVERS

1. Raise vehicle and remove both driver side wheels.

2. Remove screw securing forward end of plastic rocker

trim to inner fender liner and body.



Remove the screw securing the rear end of the plastic rocker trim to the inner fender liner and body.

4. Located on the bottom of Renegade's plastic rocker trim, you will find 6 plastic fasteners securing it to brackets extending from the pinch seam. Use a flathead screw driver to lower the fastener locking pins remove the fasteners from the plastic rocker trim.



- 9. Carefully lower and remove the rock slider.
- 10. Recreate the marks on the outward facing lip of the pinch seam and a 1/4" hole at each location.
- 11. Return the rock slider to position and loosely secure it to the pinch seam. This will keep it from moving when drilling rivet holes.

12. Drill 3/16" rivet holes using the rocker as a guide.

Note: Holes closest to the front door and rear door

require a 90 degree drill.



- 13. Use 3/16" pop rivets to secure rocker to Renegade. Rocker must be tight against sheetmetal before riveting. You may need to clamp it to hold it tight before riveting.
- 14. Secure the lower mounting edge to the pinch weld by tightening the bolts and nuts loosely installed in step 11.
- 15. Reinstall wheels.
- 16. Repeat instructions for other side.



Note: Use a towel, rag or 2x4 between jack and rocker to avoid scratching the powdercoat.

- 6. Push slider all the way forward of the vehicle, then put slight pressure on slider with jack to hold in place. Note: The circular cutout of the rocker will match the circle in the door opening.
- 7. Tuck the front and rear fender liners between the rock slider and the pinch seam.
- Using the rock slider as a template, mark where you will need to drill 5 holes on the *inner* lip of the pinch seam.



5. Using a 5mm allen wrench, remove the bolt next to the "NO STEP" warning label that secures the plastic rocker trim to body of your Renegade.



- 6. Pull the plastic rocker trim down and away to separate it from the plastic mounting tabs
- 7. Pull the fender trim away from the body to access the final tab securing the plastic rocker trim to the body. It is hidden behind the plastic fender trim.
- 8. Find the plastic tongue connecting the rocker trim to the fender trim. Wriggle it free of the slot to completely remove the rocker trim.



(The kit includes replacement tabs. To insert, slide the square side into the mounting slots. Push the barbed end into the respective hole until it clicks into place.)

INSTALLATION

 Using a razor knife, remove high spots of glue from the backside of the pinchweld and the underside of the rocker, creating a flat surface for the rocker to mount. Proper installation requires a flush surface.



Cut off the 6 rocker trim mounts from the pinch seam.
 Cut them flush with the bottom of the pinch weld.
 These must be trimmed or the rocker will not fit into place.



Note: When the glue is removed and the front and rear tabs that held the plastic panel are trimmed off, the rocker will fit snuggly against the bottom of floor behind the pinchweld, the bottom of the rocker and the door jamb; there will be no doubt that it is in

place. Note: Do not drill any holes until it is in place!

3. Trim 1" off the bottom of the front plastic inner fenderwell. Cut to just past the rectangular pinch seam dimple.



Note: This allows the lower corner of the front plastic inner fenderwell and the rear fenderwell to tuck into the rock slider.

- 4. Open both driver side doors.
- 5. Using a floorjack, carefully raise the rock slider until it's flush against the body. Make sure the pinch seam sits inside the rock slider and that the circular cutout on the upper edge is positioned around the round dimple on the body.
